**Eco Tip** During hot weather please consider helping out the wildlife in your garden. There are several simple things you can do. Provide enough water both in a shallow dish and a bird bath and keep your pond topped up; keep bird feeders topped up and scatter some bird food on the ground; provide enough cover from the sun (logs, rockeries, tall grass) and above all don't be too tidy in the garden – wilder areas provide shelter for a multitude of wildlife!
